DEBRIS REMOVAL CREWS MAKING GREAT PROGRESS

516 Properties Cleared of Burn Debris

More than 60% Now Complete

31 Crews are making great progress completing debris removal on more than 60% of participating properties and erosion control on half of those. Crews continue to work a seven day work week, weather permitting with an estimated time of completion in early April.

Residents are encouraged to submit building plans for review and complete a building permit application prior to completion of the debris removal process. Packages that are submitted for review must be completed with required documents. Only when the property is certified clean, septic system approved for use by Environmental Management Department and wells verified serviceable, will permits for re-construction be eligible for issuance.

Increased numbers and types of vehicles on county roads make driving conditions hazardous for residents and workers. Drivers are cautioned to continue to be vigilant.

While the official cutoff date for property owners to sign up for the Right-of-Entry (ROE) program has passed, additional properties are being considered on a case-by-case basis.
